What are grants?

Grants are a form of financial aid that does not need to be repaid.¹ Grant awards are usually based on financial need and are available from the state or federal government, or the college you plan to attend.

How do I apply?

1. Complete the [FAFSA](#) and submit to NCMC by using school code 002514.
2. To ensure consideration for all available grant assistance, submit your FAFSA online at fafsa.ed.gov before February 1st.
