

Articulated Credit



Changes listed below effective August 2011.

Individual course articulation

Existing and updated articulated agreements will be honored until their expiration. Students earning credit as part of those agreements have the current 15 months from graduation to enroll. Those agreements expiring prior to August 2011 and any beginning August 2011 will be enacted under the new terms.

Courses available for articulated credit will include:

AG 105 Plant Science	CD 112 Early Childhood Growth and Development
AG 107 Animal Science	CD 115 Professionalism in Early Childhood
AG 148 Agriculture Sales	CD 120 Pre-School Administration and Management

BT160 Microcomputer Applications will no longer be offered as articulated credit, only dual credit.

Requirements

The secondary institution must complete and submit a certificate of articulated credit to NCMC upon the completion of the course by the student.

Students must then:

1. Enroll at NCMC within 15 months of high school graduation.
2. Present an official articulated credit certificate at enrollment and to an advisor.
3. After completion of 12 credit hours at NCMC with at least a 2.0 GPA, apply with the Registrar's office to have the articulated credit put on the student transcript.
4. A fee of \$10 per articulated course will be required before the credit is transcribed.

1+1 (30 hour block) articulation (technical schools/career centers)

Existing and updated articulated agreements will be honored until their expiration. Students earning credit as part of those existing agreements have the current 15 months from graduation or completion of the technical school program to enroll. Those agreements expiring prior to August 2011 and any beginning August 2011 will be enacted under the new terms.

Requirements:

The secondary institution/technical school must complete and submit a certificate of articulated credit to NCMC upon the completion of the technical program by the student.

Students must then:

1. Enroll at NCMC within 15 months of high school graduation or completion of the technical school program.
2. Present an official articulated credit certificate at enrollment and to an advisor.
3. Complete the required 31 credit hours of technical and general education through NCMC with at least a 2.0 GPA.
4. Apply with the Registrar's office to have the articulated 30 hour block credit put on the student transcript.
5. A fee of \$50 will be required before the 30 hours of credit are transcribed.
