Missouri A+ Guidelines

As a certified A+ high school graduate, you are eligible for class tuition and standard fees to be paid by the Missouri A+ Program. This eligibility begins with the date of your high school graduation and continues for four years. The following guidelines for eligibility also apply:

- You must complete the application process for Federal Financial Aid (FAFSA) each year and submit ALL required documentation.
- You are eligible for a maximum of 6 semesters or until you have earned your first two-year degree or one-year certificate if degree is not intended.
- You must be a full-time degree- or certificate-seeking student attending an A+ eligible college or vocational school. "Visiting students" attending NCMC for the summer semester only **are not eligible for A+ benefits.**
- You must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher for ALL college and vocational school coursework taken AFTER high school graduation (college credit taken while in high school is excluded in the GPA calculation).
- A+ benefits will not pay for repeated coursework.
- Pell Grant funds and Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant funds, if applicable, must be applied to your bill first before A+ benefits can be applied. Depending on the amount of these combined grant funds, it is possible that you will not receive any A+ funds.
- Students may decline A+ benefits during any semester but are still required to maintain the cumulative 2.50 GPA for future A+ eligibility.
- **You are personally responsible for all tuition and fees should you fail to meet ALL of the A+ eligibility guidelines.**
