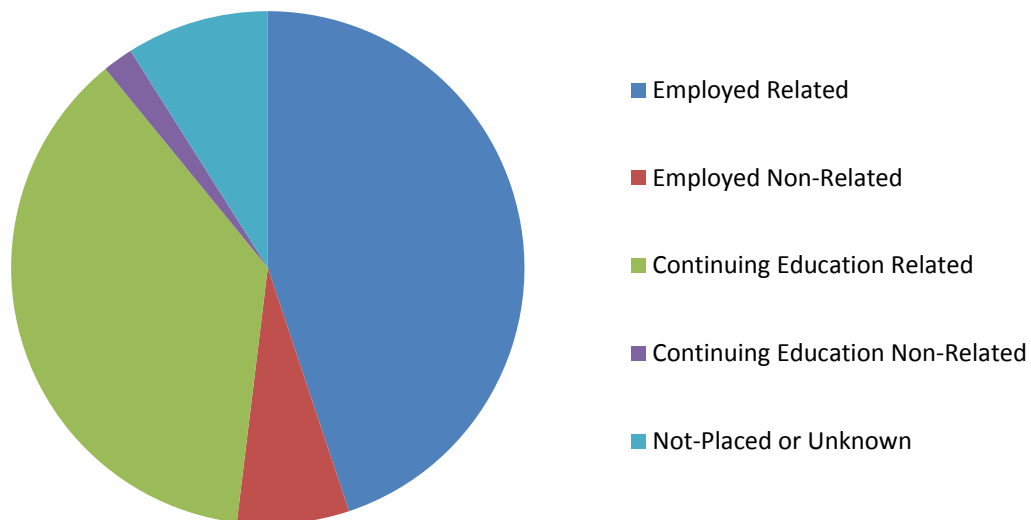


## 2010 GRADUATE FOLLOW-UP REPORT

The Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE), through the Division of Career Education, requires that all community colleges conduct a 180-day follow-up questionnaire on all occupational graduates. In 2011, NCMC included all graduates (251) in the survey process so as to collect the most comprehensive post-graduate data possible. This was also the first year that the follow-up questionnaire was provided online, and a raffle was held to offer an incentive prize for completing the questionnaire. This survey process resulted in a 62% response rate.

The questionnaire collects data from graduates that show whether students are employed in a related or non-related degree/certificate or training area; whether students are continuing education in a related or non-related degree/certificate or training area; or whether students are not placed for various reasons. As the graph below illustrates, 45% are employed in a related field, 37% are continuing their education in a related field, 7% are employed in a non-related field, and 2% are continuing their education in a non-related field.

Overall, graduates' perceptions of the quality of instruction and services at North Central Missouri College were very positive. Of the surveys returned, 92% of respondents rated quality of instruction as very good or good, and 83% of instructor advisement as very good or good. Out of the respondents, 97% said they would recommend NCMC to others. Location (54%) was the major reason students cited for choosing to attend NCMC with parents/family (38%) reported second.
