  3. Provide the committee with three letters of recommendation from the individuals in the list below. The first two letters should be from Arts and Sciences faculty who can make statements about your academic pursuits and classroom achievements. The third letter should be from someone who can describe your service component while an NCMC student, which includes volunteer work (on and off campus), student organizations, etc.
  4. Define the phrase “academic excellence,” how it applies to you and why you deserve this award. This should be a typed statement of no more than 500 words.
  5. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
