



**Baseball Video Production Internships Available  
Northwoods League Baseball  
Waterloo Bucks**

With the major upgrades that came during the 2010 season, every Northwoods League game will be video casted live over the internet on NorthwoodsLeague.tv using a 4-camera production setup. All 16 teams will have 35 home games during the regular season.

Each 4-camera broadcast will include two manually operated cameras and two remote control operated PTZ (pan-tilt-zoom) cameras. A PTZ camera will be located both behind home plate and in centerfield while the manually operated cameras will be stationed near first base and third base.

The Bucks are looking for interns to work as their video production crew. Positions on the crew include:

Director  
Producer  
Technical Director  
Camera Operator  
Video-editor  
... and more

Duties for the video production internship will consist of, but not be limited to:

Set-up/teardown of video equipment before and after each home game  
Setting up each broadcast to the NWL video network  
Filming of all 35 home Bucks games  
Editing each home game  
Producing a highlight reel of Bucks games  
Working with the Bucks radio broadcaster to set up the voice feed of the game  
Possible on-field interviews with coaches/players  
And other duties as assigned

Hours: Typically 90 minutes before each home game until the cleanup/teardown is complete after each game.
