Eligibility, Requirements and Admission Information for Ottawa University Nursing

- Acceptance **first** into NCMC Nursing Program.
- Application to Ottawa University as a degree-seeking student after NCMC acceptance is confirmed (apply online at <https://www.ottawa.edu/ou/apply-now/>).
- Meet a cumulative minimum GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 grade scale on all college coursework completed prior to admission.
- An interview with Ottawa University’s CEP Enrollment Advisor and Financial Aid representative. *Please Note: due to the unique, dual educational pathway between two colleges, students who enroll in this concurrent program may need scholarships or grants to help pay for courses at Ottawa University if they are attending NCMC during the same semester. Regulations allow for federal loans to be administered to only one institution at a time. Therefore, it will be important for interested applicants to speak with a financial aid representative at Ottawa University before enrollment.*
- BSN Graduation Requirements:
 - 124 credit hours total, 30 from Ottawa University
 - 44 hours of Upper Division courses (300 level and above)
 - Minimum of 12 hours must be completed within the major from Ottawa University Upper Division level courses
- Students must comply with all health and safety requirements, including a criminal background check, immunizations, CPR as directed by both institutions.
