

## **OVERVIEW:**

This agreement is intended to provide students who have earned an **Associate in Arts in Business Management** at North Central Missouri College (NCMC) the opportunity to complete a **Bachelor of Science in Accounting: Managerial Accounting** at Northwest Missouri State University (Northwest) during the 2023-2024 Academic Catalog. Meeting with an academic advisor is important to ensure students are meeting general education and major requirements.

#### **CONDITIONS OF TRANSFER:**

#### Section I: Admissions and Matriculation

- Under the provisions of the Memorandum of Agreement, students who meet published admissions standards will be eligible to matriculate at Northwest
   (<u>nwmissouri.edu/admissions/transfer/criteria.htm</u>). Additionally, students who meet published scholarship guidelines will be awarded accordingly at Northwest
   (<u>nwmissouri.edu/finaid/aid/scholarships/transfer.htm</u>).
- Criteria for acceptance into the School of Business will be the same for transfer as for native students as listed in the Academic Catalog.
- At least 60 percent of the comprehensive Bachelor of Science degree within the School of Business must be completed at Northwest.

#### Section II: Transfer of Credit

- Transfer credit from NCMC will be evaluated based on the academic policies section of the Academic Catalog (<u>nwmissouri.edu/academics/catalog/index.htm</u>).
- Credit for courses not listed within this agreement may be reviewed in the Transfer Equivalency System (nwmissouri.edu/admissions/transfer/tes.htm).
- Courses that are non-college level (commonly less than 100 level courses) are not transferable toward a baccalaureate degree.
- Only academic courses with passing letter grades (A, B, C, D) will be accepted for graduation requirements.
   Business and common professional component courses require a C or better. This information is specified in the Common Professional Component in the Academic Catalog.
