



## What you need to DO

- Apply to NCMC
- Obtain an FSA ID for student and parent at [fsaid.ed.gov](https://fsaid.ed.gov)
- Complete the FAFSA every academic year at [fafsa.gov](https://fafsa.gov)
- Complete all FAFSA verification requirements\*  
\*ONLY if your FAFSA is chosen for verification – any missing documents will be noted on myCOMPASS
- Send ALL official, final transcripts, including:
  - High school (with A+ seal)
  - Other institutions where you've received credit-  
Don't forget dual credit!
- Students starting college the summer after graduation
  - Submit Summer A+ Form
  - Complete two FAFSAs

## What you need to KNOW

- The A+ Scholarship DOES pay for: tuition (up to the state cap per credit hour) and student development/facility fees.
- The A+ Scholarship DOES NOT pay for: books & supplies, room & board and course-specific fees.
- Federal aid is applied first. If your federal aid (e.g., Pell Grant, SEOG) does not cover the full tuition and fees, A+ will pay for any remaining eligible amount.
- Check your Pirate email account every day — this is how we communicate with you!
- You must declare yourself as degree-seeking
- ENROLL and COMPLETE at least 6 credit hours in the summer term and/or at least 12 credit hours in the fall/spring terms.
- Maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA.
- A+ will only pay 105% of the credit hours required for your degree – that's all required classes plus one!
- A+ cannot be saved for later! If you are earning college credit, that credit is counting towards your 105%.
- Expiration occurs at whichever comes first: 48 months after high school graduation; receipt of a certificate/associate's degree; completion of 105% of the required hours for your degree. (Dual credit classes do not count toward the 105%.)
