ACADEMIC INFORMATION

- ☞ Submit official transcripts from all colleges and Military (JST) Joint Service Transcript
- ☞ Military experience, provide DD214 to Registrar for 2 elective credit hours
- ☞ NCMC accepts Clep & Credit for Prior Learning Service-based on ACE recommendations
- ☞ Individualized Academic Plan, available on Student Portal (myCOMPASS)
- ☞ Student is responsible to enroll in only classes required for declared degree (Academic plan)
- ☞ Retake courses may or may not be covered by Military/VA benefits
- ☞ **Developmental/Workshop courses will not be paid for by VA, if taken online or hybrid**
- ☞ Hybrid courses must have one standard class (50 min.) to be certified as an on campus
- ☞ NCMC will share student grades and courses enrolled with the service member's branch
- ☞ Credit hours are certified with the start/end date specific to each course, which may affect your full-time status with the VA & housing
- ☞ **Students who fail to maintain standards of attendance, progress, and conduct will be reported to the VA resulting in the potential loss of benefits**
- ☞ Student must notify NCMC's Military/Veteran Academic Advisor if you change degrees:
 - A new Academic plan must be completed each time you change your degree.
 - **The new Academic plan must be on file with the Military/Veteran Academic Advisor before the School Certifying Official will certify hours of enrollment.**

TUITION ASSISTANCE

- *Tuition Assistance (TA) must be submitted and approved by student’s Service 10 days BEFORE the start date of classes.
- Service members will be solely responsible for all tuition costs without prior approval from their service.
- TA students with grades below a C or Fail for “pass/fail” courses will be recouped by the service member.
- Student is responsible for scheduling classes on the Academic plan.
- Tuition of unapproved classes will be the sole responsibility of the student.
