PHYSICAL DEMANDS

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently required to sit & stand, walk, climb out of the pool; use hands and fingers, handle or feel objects, be able to lift individuals of various sizes out of the pool, reach with hands and arms; stoop, kneel, crouch; smell and hear. The employee must occasionally lift and/or move up to 30 pounds. The employee must be able to perform all the duties and skills necessary to be a lifeguard.

WORK ENVIRONMENT

While performing the duties of this job, the individual will be exposed to humid conditions. The typical noise level in the Pool Area may be loud. The individual may be exposed to toxic or caustic chemicals occasionally when/if working with the cleaning supplies.

EFFECT ON THE END RESULT

The Lifeguard position, as part of the YMCA Team, will allow for more consistent and quality customer service by making members feel welcome and increase their sense of belonging to the YMCA. This position will strengthen our ability to give a safe aquatic environment. The overall result of these actions will create engaged members with a strong connection to the YMCA. Their positive experiences will result in members and participants becoming ambassadors for the YMCA.
