# UPWARD BOUND

## SUMMER 2022

Students who will be participating in the 5 week residential component will move in and complete registration on **Monday, May 30 at 6:00 p.m.** A parent/guardian must be in attendance on this day to complete necessary paperwork and help their student get settled into their dorm room.

**Parent Meeting:** There will be a brief meeting for **ALL** parents/guardians following registration. This will allow everyone to meet summer staff, ask questions, and to talk to staff personally. Staff will also discuss the calendar of events, attendance/disciplinary expectations, and a general overview of the summer program.

A summer packet containing summer forms will be given out at April Extreme Saturday. These forms need to be completed and returned on Monday, May 30 or prior.

**Bridge Students:** will begin on Monday, June 6th. A parent/guardian must be present if the Bridge student is under the age of 18. Bridge students will begin at 8:00 a.m. June 6 (courses begin at that time)- so show up early. UB will provide books and supplies- stop by the office

## OPT-OUT STUDENTS

Students who do not participate in the residential program will still need to participate in an online component (same time frame as residential) to remain active in Upward Bound next year. Students will be eligible to receive a stipend for each week they complete their weekly assigned activity. Directions will be available on Brightspace and will also be given to students at April Extreme Saturday. Week 1 activities will begin on Monday, May 30.

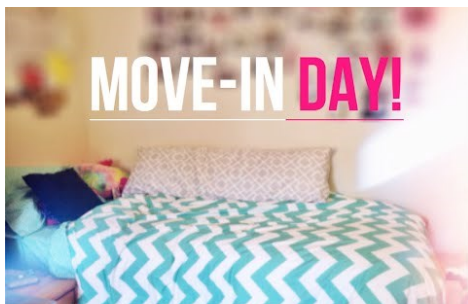

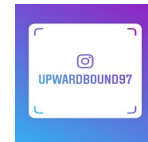
